in Istanbul on 27th of May 2011

The Participants of the 10th Congress of South-East European Freight Forwarders and Logistics Operators, who gathered in Istanbul on 26th and 27th of May 2011, whilst

- Expressing their condolences to Japan for the disastrous effects of the recent earthquake and tsunami;
- Taking into consideration the difficulties of their regional economies;
- Observing the price increase of minerals, foods and other commodities is lambasting the global economic recovery;
- Understanding the importance of the protections of the environment for a better future;

Believe the joint efforts of the logistics industry can lead to rapid improvements for the unhindered flow of the goods in Southeast Europe;

Affirm that the Forwarding Industry is still under threat from excessive bureaucracy and barriers, which impede the improvement of transport and logistics working conditions;





Therefore Recommend

- **Swift implementation** of the EU security advance information filing system at the same time in all countries of the region, in order to avoid any business disruption;
- Protecting the forwarders' rights in the implementation of the EU security advance information filing system, by facilitating their relationship with carriers and by providing a dual filing system as early as possible;
- Updating of simplified customs procedures at border crossings and at nationwide applications, according to the new e-Customs standards;
- Continue investments to improve the quality of the existing transport infrastructure, as well as building new infrastructure;
- Supporting EU and region wide green logistics practices;
- Resolving non-tariff barriers between the countries of the region;
- Encouraging innovative thinking and research for alternative transport modes and routes in order to overcome existing bottlenecks;
- Strengthening the relationship between Southeast European countries and their neighbours to improve regional cooperation and to develop the relations with the Federation of Economic Cooperation Organization Logistics Providers Associations (ECOLPAF);
- Harmonising the safety regulations in all Southeast European Countries;

By signing this declaration, the representatives of the Associations below, approve and accept the above principles.
